Over 11,000 estates are held by HM Treasury Office and lay unclaimed, so there is a large and growing need for more, new Heir Hunters to unlock the mysteries of these estates and reunite heirs with those dormant fortunes.

HHA Members come in all ages and locations, many with a pre-existing interest in tracing their own family history. They work from home often alongside a normal day job, others take it up in retirement, or following redundancy. The HHA is the UK's foremost source on Heir Hunting.
